The Long Term Issuer Rating, considering the outlook as negative, has been downgraded to 'IND A-' from 'IND A'. Also, the Commercial Paper Programme's Rating was downgraded, considering INR 644.5 million (reduced from INR 1,000 million) to 'INDA2+' from 'IND A1'. The ratings have been downgraded primarily due to decline in EBITDA margin and elongation of net working capital cycle.




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
